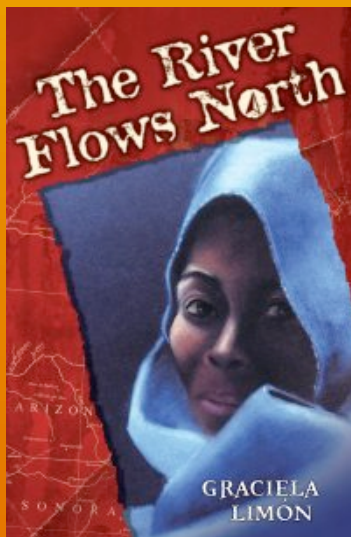

Graciela Limón has won an American Book Award and many other prizes. She writes about the lives of Mexican Americans, the Southwest of the U.S.A., colonial Mexico, the Zapatista uprising, migration, family, and cultural identity. She will read from her seventh novel, *The River Flows North* (2009), in which each member of a group of illegal border crossers—struggling to survive the trek across the Arizona desert—remembers the reasons for leaving home.
